




















Barefoot Mardi Gras

TSUNAMI

The "Tsunami" cocktail is a tropical and refreshing drink that brings the flavors of the beach right to your glass. This vibrant mix combines the sweet and exotic notes of coconut rum with the bright blue hues of Blue Curacao, creating a stunning visual reminiscent of crashing ocean waves. The addition of Peach Schnapps adds a juicy, fruity kick, resulting in a well balanced and irresistible cocktail that will make you feel like you're riding the crest of a delicious wave.

Ingredients

- 1 oz vodka
- 1 oz coconut rum
- 1 oz peach schnapps
- 1 oz blue curacao

Directions

- 1. In a cocktail shaker with ice cubes, add the coconut rum, blue curacao, peach schnapps and vodka.
- 2. Shake well until the ingredients are thoroughly chilled.
- 3. Strain the mixture into a chilled glass filled with ice. Optional garnish with a slice of peach or a cherry for an extra tropical touch.


