DID YOU KNOW?

Pop Tabs for Ronald McDonald House Charities

Parrot Head Clubs across the country have actively participated in this initiative for many years. It's a meaningful cause that requires minimal effort. Here are some key points about this program:

- While we could collect whole cans, the compact size of the tabs minimizes storage and transport challenges. Even a partially crushed can takes up mostly air, whereas tabs are purely metal, generally free from drink residues, and a container of tabs has minimal wasted space.
- These tabs can be sold to recyclers by weight, making one cubic foot of tabs significantly more valuable than the same volume of cans.
- It takes around 1,128 pop tabs to make up a pound, and the current pricing ranges from \$0.40 to \$0.50 per pound.
- A milk jug filled with can tabs, weighing about 2.5 pounds, can be valued at approximately \$1.25 to \$2.50 based on the scrap aluminum price.

This is a wonderful way to support the Ronald McDonald House Charities. Not only does it keep our commitment to helping others top of mind, but it also has a positive long-term impact on children in need.

Our Club is dedicated to finding the easiest way for you to collect and donate your pop tabs. Please store them at home and bring them to our various Club events. Once we have gathered a substantial amount, a few members will take them to the Ronald McDonald House.

HOUSE CONCERTS

Guests typically roll in 30 to 45 minutes early, armed with potluck goodies and their beverage of choice—no snitching someone else's fancy brew, though!

Musical magic lasts about 60 to 90 minutes, then it's time for a quick refresh, chatter, and snack attack. The encore?
