CANDY CANE MARGARITA

Instructions

Prepare your cocktail glass by running a lime wedge along the rim and dipping it in sugar to create a frosty edge.

Fill the glass with ice cubes.

Mix cranberry juice, Blanco Tequila, orange liqueur, and peppermint extract in a cocktail shaker.

Shake vigorously until well-blended.

Pour the mixture over the ice in your prepared glass.

Top the cocktail with raspberry seltzer water for a refreshing fizz.

Sprinkle the top with crushed candy canes for a festive flair.

Garnish with a candy cane for the perfect holiday presentation.

Ingredients

2 oz. Blanco Tequila

6 oz Cranberry Juice

½ oz Orange Liqueur

2 Drops Peppermint Extract

Raspberry Seltzer Water

1 tbsp Crushed Candy Cane

Candy Cane for Garnish

Lime Wedge for Rim

Colored Sugar for Rim

PEPPERMINT BARK-ARITA

Ingredients

2 oz silver tequila

1 oz white crème de cacao or white chocolate liqueur

1 oz peppermint schnapps

1 oz fresh lime juice

1 oz cream (or half and half for extra richness)

Ice

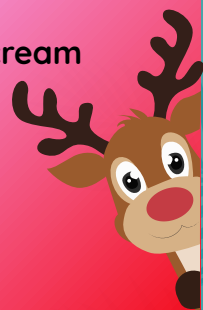
Instructions

Crush peppermint candies or candy canes and pour on to a small plate. Rim your glasses with chocolate syrup, then dip into crushed peppermint for that frosty festive sparkle.

In a shaker, combine tequila, crème de cacao, peppermint schnapps, lime juice, cream and ice. Shake like a reindeer trying to make the nice list.

Strain over fresh ice into your peppermint rimmed glass.

Top with whipped cream, a sprinkle of crushed peppermint, and a mini candy cane for flair. (optional, but highly encouraged)

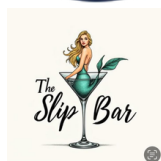
